1 Plaintiff Francisco Carrasco ("Plaintiff" or "Class Representative") and Defendant
2 Vince, LLC ("Vince" or "Defendant") (collectively with Plaintiff, the "Parties"), by and
3 through their counsel of record, hereby stipulate as follows with reference to the following
4 facts:

5 WHEREAS, on March 3, 2020, this Court entered an order granting final approval of the
6 proposed class settlement between the Parties and scheduled a Compliance Hearing for December
7 10, 2020 at 9:15 a.m. in Department 23;

8 WHEREAS, on June 12, 2020, this Court re-scheduled the Compliance Hearing in this

14 WHEREAS, the Parties intend that all other terms and obligations not addressed herein, as
15 set forth in the Settlement Agreement, the Order Granting Final Approval, and the Judgment,
16 remain unchanged.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties hereby stipulate as follows:

18 1. The deadline for Defendant to fund the settlement pursuant to the terms of the
19 Settlement Agreement shall be extended to thirty (30) calendar days to August 24, 2020;

20 2. The deadline for the Settlement Administrator to disburse settlement funds to the
21 settlement class members shall be fifteen (15) calendar days from the date of funding, no later
22 than September 8, 2020.

23 3. Settlement payments shall be void 180 days after issuance (no later than March 8,
24 2021).

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4. The Compliance Hearing shall be continued to April 2, 2021 at 9:15 a.m. in Department 23, or to a later date at the Court's convenience.


