Plaintiff Barbara Farinha's ("Plaintiff") Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class

Action Settlement came before this Court, on June 12, 2020, the Honorable Michael W. Jones,

Judge presiding. The Court having considered the papers submitted in support of the

application of the parties, HEREBY GRANTS THE MOTION FOR PRELIMINARY

APPROVAL OF CLASS ACTION SETTLEMENT AND ORDERS THE FOLLOWING:

- The Court grants preliminary approval of the settlement based upon the terms
  set forth in the Stipulation of Settlement and Release (hereinafter referred to as
  "Settlement Agreement") filed herewith. The Settlement appears to be fair,
  adequate and reasonable to the Class.
- The Settlement Agreement falls within the range of reasonableness and appears
  to be presumptively valid, subject only to any objections that may be raised at
  the final fairness hearing and final approval by this Court.
