If you believe the number of Individual overnight shifts listed above is incorrect, check the box below, and send this FLSA Opt-In Form, a letter, and supporting documentation to the Settlement Administrator indicating what you believe are the correct number of Individual offshore overnight shifts you worked for Secorp as an hourly employee, on an oil platform on the Outer Continental Shelf off any coast of the United States and, during such shifts, were furnished any meals and/or lodging in addition to other wages during the time period September 13, 2016 through January 29, 2021.

The Settlement Administrator will resolve any dispute based upon Secorp’s records and any documents and information you provide. Please be advised that the number of shifts is presumed to be correct unless the documents you submit are company records from Secorp.
