Pursuant to the Order Granting Final Approval of Class Action Settlement entered on August 16, 2021, it is hereby **ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED** as follows:

1. Judgment in this matter is entered in accordance with the Court’s Order Granting Final Approval of Class Action Settlement (“Order”) and the Parties’ Stipulation for Class Action Settlement (“Settlement Agreement”) ^{as amended} Unless otherwise provided herein, all capitalized terms used herein shall have the same meaning as defined in the Settlement Agreement.

1 2. ~~As provided by the Order, all Class Members, other than any Excluded Class~~
2 ~~Members, are barred from pursuing, or seeking to reopen, any of the released claims, as provided in~~
3 ~~the Settlement Agreement and the Order.~~ Consistent with the definitions provided in the Settlement
4 Agreement, the Settlement Class consists of "All current and former employees, who were employed
5 by Defendants in the State of California between February 26, 2016 through the April 9, 2021 in the
6 position of Student Loan Advisors, Student Loan Processors, or similar positions.


7 3. Plaintiff, Kalvyn Escobar, and the Class Members shall take from their First Amended
8 Complaint the relief set forth in (a) the Order; and (b) the Order Awarding Fees, Costs and
9 Enhancement Award, ~~each pursuant to the terms of the Settlement Agreement.~~

10 4. Pursuant to the Settlement Agreement, California Code of Civil Procedure Section
11 664.4 and Rule 3.769(h) of the California Rules of Court, this Court retains exclusive and continuing
12 jurisdiction over the parties, including all Class Members, to enforce the terms of the Settlement
13 Agreement, the Order, and this Judgment.

14 5. This document shall constitute a judgment (and separate document constituting said
15 judgment) for purposes of California Rules of Court, Rule 3.769(h).
