NATURE OF PROCEEDINGS: Hearing on Motion for Final Approval of Settlement

Due to Judge Yvette Palazuelos being unavailable this date, the matter is called for hearing before Judge David S. Cunningham, III.

The Court issues the following ruling:

Grant Final Approval. The Court Grants: (1) \$133,333 in fees to class counsel Diversity Law Group, PC; (2) \$7,610.70 in costs to class counsel; (3) \$12,500 for claims administration costs to Simpluris, Inc.; (4) \$15,000 (75% of \$20,000 penalty) to the LWDA.; and (5) an enhancement award of \$7,500 to the named Plaintiff.

Plaintiffs' counsel shall file a proposed Order and Judgement, consistent with this ruling the class definition, full release language, and names of members who opted out by February 18, 2020. That order shall include two distinct procedures by which the parties and court will comply with CCP Section 384's amended provisions with regards to cy pres recipients.

Thirty (30) days after the final report is filed with the Court, the parties shall prepare and file a stipulation and proposed order and Proposed Amended Judgment.

The stipulation and proposed order shall include, inter alia, the amount of the distribution of unpaid cash residue, and unclaimed or abandoned funds to the non-party, the accrued interest on that sum and any other information required to be set forth pursuant to Section 68520 of the Government Code, as incorporated into CCP Section 384.5.

The stipulation shall be signed by counsel for the class, defendant's counsel and counsel for (or an authorized representative of) the non-party ("cy pres") recipient. The stipulation shall include a statement to the effect that all interested persons are in accord with the amended judgment and have no objection to the entry of an amended judgment. If there are objections by any party,

class counsel shall immediately notify the court and the matter will be set for further hearing.

The Court orders class counsel to file a final report summarizing all distributions made pursuant to the approved settlement, supported by declaration.
