DECLARATION OF SILVIA VALDIVIA DE CABRERA

I, Silvia Valdivia De Cabrera, declare:

- 1. I am a named plaintiff in this case. As such, I have personal knowledge of, or am informed and believe, the following facts herein stated. If called as a witness, I could and would testify competently to such facts.
- 2. I have devoted a substantial amount of my time, both before this lawsuit was filed and during its litigation to ensure a fair result for the class.
- 3. My participation began with bringing certain issues that are involved in this matter to my lawyers' attention and explaining the factual background that was used to prosecute the claims in this case.
- 4. For example, I provided relevant documents to my lawyers, including payroll records, timesheets, the employee handbook and other policies and procedures, and I discussed documents and related facts with my lawyers to assist them in prosecuting this case.
- 5. I provided my lawyers with information about working conditions, work shifts, compensation, meal and rest breaks, and overtime pay to assist my lawyers in prosecuting this case. I also discussed the status of the case with my lawyers.
- 6. My efforts continued after suit was filed. For example, I continued to identify current and former employees and other witnesses to my lawyers, along with other information as to how they could be of potential use in this matter.
- 7. I spent numerous hours speaking with and providing information to my lawyers both before and during this litigation.
- 8. In sum, I have provided over a dozen hours of my time during the course of this litigation to ensure a good outcome for the best interests of the class.
- 9. I have assumed some long-lasting risk in prosecuting this case as a named plaintiff. Because it is easy to search for information online these days, I believe I will face an increased risk that future employers will discover information about this lawsuit

online and have a negative reaction to learning that I sued an employer. This may make it harder for me to obtain future employment or change jobs.
