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TO ALL PARTIES AND THEIR RESPECTIVE COUNSEL OF RECORD:

The Motion for Preliminary Approval of a Class Action Settlement came before this Court, on January 13, 2021, the Honorable Thomas S. Clark presiding. The Court having considered the papers submitted in support of the application of the parties, HEREBY ORDERS THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. The Court grants preliminary approval of the Settlement and the Settlement Class based upon the terms set forth in the Stipulation and Agreement of Compromise and Settlement of Class and Representative Action ("Settlement Agreement") filed with the Declaration of Craig J. Ackermann on December 1, 2020. All terms used herein shall have the same meaning as defined in the Settlement Agreement. The Settlement Agreement appears to be fair, adequate and reasonable to the Class.
- The Settlement falls within the range of reasonableness and appears to be presumptively valid, subject only to any objections that may be raised at the final fairness hearing and final approval by this Court.
- 3. A final fairness hearing on the question of whether the proposed Settlement, attorneys' fees and costs to Class Counsel, and the Class Representatives' Enhancement Awards should be finally approved as fair, reasonable and adequate as to the members of the Class is scheduled in Department 17 on the date and time set forth in the implementation schedule in Paragraph 10 below.
- 4. This Court approves, as to form and content, the Class Notice, in substantially the form attached to the Settlement Agreement as **Exhibit A**. The Court approves the procedure for Class Members to participate in, to opt out of, and to object to, the Settlement as set forth in the Stipulation of Settlement.
- 5. The Court directs the mailing of the Class Notice by first class mail to the Class Members in accordance with the Implementation Schedule set forth below. The Court finds the dates selected for the mailing and distribution of the Notice, as set forth in the Implementation Schedule, meet the requirements of due process and provide the best notice practicable under the

circumstances and shall constitute due and sufficient notice to all persons entitled thereto.

- 6. It is ordered that the Settlement Class is preliminarily certified for settlement purposes only.
- 7. The Court confirms Plaintiffs Khalid Abu-Dayyeh and Aminah Uwais as Class Representatives, and Craig J. Ackermann of Ackermann & Tilajef, P.C. and Amir Seyedfarshi of Employment Rights Law Group, APC as Class Counsel.
- The Court confirms Phoenix Settlement Administration as the Settlement Administrator.
- 9. To facilitate administration of the Settlement pending final approval, the Court hereby enjoins Plaintiffs and all Class Members from filing or prosecuting any claims, suits or administrative proceedings (including filing claims with the Division of Labor Standards Enforcement of the California Department of Industrial Relations) regarding claims released by the Settlement, unless and until such Class Members have filed valid Requests for Exclusion with the Settlement Administrator and the time for filing claims with the Settlement Administrator has elapsed.
 - 10. The Court orders the following <u>Implementation Schedule</u> for further proceedings:

a.	Deadline for Defendant to Submit Class Member Information to Settlement Administrator	[30 days after the Preliminary Approval Date]
b.	Deadline for Settlement Administrator to Mail Notice to Class Members	[Within 45 days following the Preliminary Approval Date]
c.	Deadline for Class Members to Postmark Challenges	[60 days after mailing of the Class Notice]
d.	Deadline for Class Members to Postmark Requests for Exclusion	[60 days after mailing of the Class Notice]
e	Deadline for Class Members to submit any Objections to Settlement	[60 days after mailing of the Class Notice]

f.	Deadline for Settlement Administrator to file Declaration of Due Diligence and Proof of Mailing	[30 days prior to Final Approval and Fairness Hearing]
