

In the order approving settlement, dated 08/03/20, Hon. Wilson ordered plaintiff to "submit a final report at least 5 court days prior to the final accounting including the actual amounts paid to aggrieved employees, the other amounts distributed under the settlement, and the amounts tendered to the Unclaimed Property Division." Review of the ROA reveals that the third-party administrator apparently tried to file something on 03/12/21, but that filing was

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	Equilon Enterprises, LLC30-2010- 00395208	This is a putative class action involving alleged wage/hour violations. The file was previously in the inventory of Hon. Claster. On 09/16/20, and again on 09/24/20, he granted preliminary approval and provisional certification, ordering counsel to distribute Notice thereof to all class members. The best this Court can tell, that Notice never went out. Instead, during the administrative steps to disseminate Notice, the parties uncovered additional issues associated with the proposed settlement.  This is a status conference, though technically more of a renewed motion for preliminary approval (not a true motion for reconsideration, as styled). The proposed changes to the settlement are reasonable innocuous and certainly no basis for overturning an otherwise approved settlement. The concern for this Court is that (1) the motion is not before Hon. Claster and (2) the proposed order accompanying the new papers are not consistent with the orders signed by Hon. Claster on 09/16/20 or 09/24/20.  Hearing continued to 05/14/21. At least 15 calendar days prior thereto, counsel shall submit a proposed order approving the renewed application for preliminary approval based on the recent changed, but consistent with Hon. Claster's prior orders. If a satisfactory proposed order is received, this Court may elect to enter that order without an additional hearing.  MP give notice.
