IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED THAT:

- 1. Judgment is hereby entered in accordance with the terms of this Court's Final Approval Order.
 - 2. The Settlement Class is defined as:

"All persons, who have not otherwise released their claims against L'Oreal, regarding whom Defendant procured or caused to be procured a consumer report for employment

purposes during the Class Period." The Class Period is, as defined in the Agreement, the time period from and including July 10, 2013 through and including July 1, 2015.

- 3. Lydia Bell, Marion Dwyer, Susan Ladoux, Mia Liguori, Geza Lux Lii, Binita Patel, Emily Rejouis, Naomi Ryseff, and Sabrena Wright submitted valid and timely requests for exclusion and shall therefore be excluded from the Settlement.
- 4. The Class Representative and each Settlement Class Member who have not properly excluded themselves shall take nothing from their complaint in this action except as set forth in (i) the Final Approval Order; (ii) Settlement Agreement; and (iii) the Order Granting Motion for Approval of Attorneys' Fees and Costs, and Plaintiff's Enhancement Payment, also filed June 28, 2021.
- 5. Pursuant to the Settlement Agreement, section 664.6 of the California Code of Civil Procedure, and rule 3.769(h) of the California Rules of Court, this Court retains jurisdiction over the Class Representative, each Class Member who has not properly excluded themselves, and defendant, to enforce the terms of the Settlement Agreement, the Final Approval Order, and this Judgment.
