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## TO ALL PARTIES AND THEIR RESPECTIVE COUNSEL OF RECORD:

The Motion for Preliminary Approval of a Class Action Settlement came before this Court, on October 5, 2021, in Department 53, before the Honorable Shama H. Mesiwala presiding. The Court having considered the papers submitted in support of the application of the parties, HEREBY ORDERS THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. The Court grants preliminary approval of the Settlement and the Settlement Class based upon the terms set forth in the Joint Stipulation of Settlement and Release ("Stipulation of Settlement"). All terms used herein shall have the same meaning as defined in the Stipulation of Settlement. The settlement set forth in the Stipulation of Settlement ("Settlement") appears to be fair, adequate and reasonable to the Class.
- 2. The Settlement falls within the range of reasonableness and appears to be presumptively valid, subject only to any objections that may be raised at the final fairness hearing and final approval by this Court.
- 3. A final fairness hearing on the question of whether the proposed Settlement, attorneys' fees to Class Counsel, and the Class Representative's Enhancement Award should be finally approved as fair, reasonable and adequate as to the members of the Class is scheduled in Department 53 on the date and time set forth in the implementation schedule below.
- 4. This Court approves, as to form and content, the Notice of Proposed Class Action Settlement and Fairness Hearing ("Notice") in substantially the form attached to the Stipulation and Settlement of Class Action Claims as **Exhibit A**. The Court approves the procedure for Class Members to participate in, to opt out of, and to object to, the Settlement as set forth in the Stipulation and Settlement of Class Action Claims, and the Notice.
- 5. The Court directs the mailing of the Notice by first class mail to the Class Members in accordance with the Implementation Schedule set forth below. The Court finds the dates selected for the mailing and distribution of the Notice, as set forth in the Implementation Schedule, meet the requirements of due process and provide the best notice practicable under the circumstances and shall constitute due and sufficient notice to all persons entitled thereto.

6. It is ordered that the Settlement Class is preliminarily certified for settlement purposes only.

- 7. The Court confirms Plaintiffs Shaun Rooney, Fred Zepeda, and Teresa Aguilera as the Class Representatives, and Timothy B. Del Castillo and Kent L. Bradbury of Castle Law: California Employment Counsel, PC; Larry Lee and Max Gavron of Diversity Law Group PC; William L. Marder of Polaris Law Group; and David Yeremian and Roman Shkodnik of David Yeremian & Associates. Inc. as class counsel.
- 8. The Court confirms Phoenix Settlement Administrators as the Settlement Administrator.
- 9. To facilitate administration of the Settlement pending final approval, the Court hereby enjoins Plaintiff and all Class Members from filing or prosecuting any claims, suits or administrative proceedings (including filing claims with the Division of Labor Standards Enforcement of the California Department of Industrial Relations) regarding claims released by the Settlement, unless and until such Class Members have filed valid Requests for Exclusion with the Settlement Administrator.
  - 10. The Court orders the following <u>Implementation Schedule</u> for further proceedings:
