2. Juvenile proceedings not before a referee or commissioner under Welfare & Institutions Code sections 347 and 677;
3. Felony cases under Code of Civil Procedure section 269; and
4. "Withdrawal of consent to adopt" proceedings under Family Code section 9005.

For all other, non-statutorily-mandated cases, litigants who need court reporter services, and who are not entitled to a court-provided reporter due to indigency, will need to arrange for such services in advance of the hearing.


