PROPOSED ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR PRELIMINARY APPROVAL OF

CLASS AND REPRESENTATIVE PAGA ACTION SETTLEMENT

On April 13, 2013, the motion by Plaintiffs George Stickles and Michele Rhodes (together "Plaintiffs") for preliminary approval of a proposed Class and PAGA Action Settlement Agreement and Release of Claims ("Settlement") with Defendants Atria Senior Living, Inc. and Atria Management Company, LLC (together "Atria") came on regularly for hearing. The Court, having carefully considered the motion, its supporting papers, and the arguments of counsel, ORDERS as follows:

- 1. Preliminarily approval of the Settlement is GRANTED, effective April 13, 2023.
- 2. The Court appoints Phoenix Class Action ("Phoenix") as the settlement administrator and directs Phoenix to complete dissemination of the notices of the proposed Settlement and opt-out form as outlined in the Settlement subject to the following modifications:
 - a. The deadline for class members to opt-out of or object to the proposed Settlement is extended from 45 days to 70 days from the date of Phoenix's mailing of the notices of Settlement and the notices shall be revised to reflect the extended response deadline; and
 - b. The class notice shall be revised to advise class members that (1) they may obtain and review Plaintiffs' counsel's motion for attorneys' fees, costs, and service award by accessing the Court docket in this case through the Court's Public Access to Court Electronic Records (PACER) system at https://ecf.cand.uscourts.gov. and (2) the attorneys' fees, costs, and service award will be deducted from the settlement fund and reduce the recovery of each class member.
- 3. A final approval (fairness) hearing is set for October 10, 2023, at 11:00 a.m. in Courtroom 12 to consider the fairness, reasonableness, and adequacy of the Settlement as well as the award of attorneys' fees and costs to class counsel and a service award to the class representative.
- 4. Class counsel shall file the motion for an award of attorneys' fees, costs, and service award by no later than seven (7) days after Phoenix disseminates any notices of the

Settlement.

- 5. Class counsel shall file the motion for final approval of the Settlement, along with responses to any objections to the Settlement, no later than 35 days before the final approval (fairness) hearing.
- 6. The final pretrial conference previously scheduled for April 19, 2023 and the trial previously scheduled to commence on April 24, 2023 are vacated and will be rescheduled if final approval of the Settlement is not granted.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
